About the St Vincent de Paul Society

The St Vincent de Paul Society works at the forefront of welfare and seeks to alleviate suffering and promote human dignity without regard for people's race, religion, colour or gender. They help over 660,000 Victorians each year and comprise some 8,000 members and volunteers who aim to provide practical and emotional support to people who are experiencing poverty, loneliness and isolation. The Society runs a vast suite of services including home, hospital and prison visitation, homeless services, drug & alcohol rehabilitation, family violence support, aged care and support for people with a mental illness or disability. The Society is one of the largest and most cost effective welfare organisations in Australia with administration costs representing just 8.8% of total net income.

The Vinnies CEO Sleepout and Compu-Stor

On June 17th, 2010, Jeremy and Robert Manford took part in the inaugural national Vinnies CEO Sleepout. Held simultaneously in capital cities across Australia, the event raised over \$2.9m nationally and helped to raise awareness of the issue of homelessness. Over 105,000 people sleep rough every night in Australia and these damning statistics motivated both Jeremy and Robert to help. Jeremy slept out in Melbourne and Robert braved the event in Perth. Described as a "real eye opener", Jeremy and Robert felt there was another opportunity to give back to the community. "Not only does Compu-Stor provide jobs for Australians, we also felt that by donating a percentage of every box sold we can help provide badly needed funding to the St Vincent De Paul Society. This in turn will assist the communities in which we operate." Compu-Stor, along with the St Vincent De Paul Society, hopes that by raising awareness of homelessness, people will be inspired to stop and think for one moment about what would it be like to spend a night on the streets.
